New Season Meeting

All parents and players will be required to attend a Parent and Player Meeting at the start of the season. This will take place during the first training session after pre season.

Registration

All girls who are playing/training for Bury NC MUST be registered. You will be required to complete a registration form and pay a registration fee. Your child will then be affiliated with England Netball and will have their own personal affiliation number. This is required in order to play in leagues, tournaments and to attend County/Thunder trials. All registration forms must be returned (with full payment) by the 6th September 2018. Payment by cash or cheque (payable to YWCA Bury Netball Club) should be made at the desk.

Training Fees

Our new training cost will be £20 per Calendar month. Please could you make sure you update your old standing order ready for September. Payments should be made by standing order ONLY. (Standing order forms can be collected from the desk or downloaded from our website.) The only option for cash payment is £7 per week.

52 weeks in a year, less 10 weeks holidays = 42 training weeks.

Your standing order payments cover the 42 training weeks at £5.72 per week.

$42 \times £5.72 = £240.24$, this is divided into 12 equal monthly standing order payments of £20.00.

Please keep your standing order running throughout the year.
