Welcome to YWCA Netball,

Please see key information that you will require for the season. Ongoing information throughout the year will be communicated via your team manager, Facebook, Twitter and training sessions.

Training Tuesdays

U9's, U10's ...5.45pm-7.15pm @ Philips Sport for all centre.

U11's, U13's... 6.00pm-7.30pm @ Philips Sport for all centre.

Training Thursday

U12's, U14's & U15b's6.00pm-7.30pm @ Philips Sport for all centre.

U15a's, U16's & Seniors... 7.30pm-9.00pm @ Philips Sport for all centre.

Please bring a drink of water or squash (no fizzy drinks).

Please ensure hair is tied up, nails are clipped short & no jewellery to be worn.

Please wear sports kit and trainers. (Training kit is available to order through YWCA. Please ask at the desk for more information). It should be noted that YWCA Playing kit and YWCA Training kit are different and that the Playing kit should not be worn in training sessions.

Match kit is available online (Top, Skort, Socks & Dresses sizes (XXS, XS, S) available from www.netballuk.co.uk We have the larger sizes (M, L, XL, XXL) in stock. If you require these then please see Janine.

Please do not purchase YWCA playing kit unless you have been selected to play for the club. Speak to your coach to confirm before purchase.

If you are unable to attend training, you must inform your team manager by text. Failure to do so may result in your child not being selected for games.

All girls that are playing / training for Bury Netball Club **MUST** be registered. You will be required to complete a registration form and pay a registration fee. Your child will then be affiliated with England Netball and will have their own personal affiliation number. This is required in order to be able to play in leagues, tournaments and attend County/Thunder trials.

Please can we have all registration forms returned (with full payment) by September 15th 2016. Payment by cash or Cheque (payable to YWCA Bury Netball Club) should be made at the desk.

Training Fees are £15 per calendar month. This should be paid by standing order. Please collect a standing order form from the desk and make arrangements with your bank. Alternatively, if this is not possible, you can pay weekly at the desk (£5.00pp).

YWCA Standing Order Breakdown

52 weeks in a year, less 11 holiday weeks = 41 training weeks.

Your standing order payments cover the 41 training weeks at = £ 4.39 per week.

$41 \times £4.39 = £179.99$, this is divided into 12 equal monthly standing order payments of £15.00.

So please keep your standing order running throughout the year.

Beyond December 16th 2016, players **will not** be allowed to train **or** play with YWCA Bury if they are members of other Netball Clubs.
